Sunday the 12th of September saw the first – and hopefully not last – edition of the “Heroes concert”, a mini day music festival in aid of Help For Heroes (<http://www.helpforheroes.org.uk>) a British charity set up to help wounded soldiers.

Covered by the UK’s number 1 commercial station, Heart FM, Heroes was a star-studded affair with performances by X Factor winner Alexandra Burke, soul rapper Plan B, peroxide blond with the big voice Pixie Lott, ex military man and pop singer James Blunt, Spanish heartthrob Enrique Iglesias, pop band The Saturdays, new kids on the block (with already a number 1 single under their belt) The Wanted, legendary crooner Tom Jones and last, but certainly not least Take That’s Robbie Williams and Gary Barlow, who performed on stage together for the first time in 15 years.
